Fees for rally include the \$3.50 AKC Recording Fee on each entry of a dog in rally and a \$3.00 fee for each additional entry of the same dog. Note: There is no Recording Fee or Event Service Fee for junior showmanship, sweepstakes, futurities, brace/team, multi-dog classes or special attractions.
- 2) Fee for **4-6 Month Beginner Puppy** includes the \$2.00 AKC Recording Fee per entry.

Herding Titled (NATIONAL SPECIALTY ONLY)

Winners of the Herding Titled and Veterans classes will advance to compete in Best of Breed provided they have not been defeated in any other single entry class.

Herding Titled - This class is to honor those dogs and bitches who have distinguished themselves in the job for which they were bred. Dogs & bitches are eligible to compete if they have one or more AKC herding titles. Herding Instinct Certificates do not meet the eligibility requirements of this class. Entries must be intact (no spaved or neutered allowed). They may or may not have a Championship.

Awards of Merit (National Specialty Only)

Awards of Merit (National Specialty Only)

ABMC Awards of Merit may be awarded, at the judge's discretion, to a small number of dogs / bitches eligible for Best of Breed. These awards are reserved for those outstanding entries that the judge feels worthy of final consideration for Best of Breed.

Points Available for Reserve (National Specialty Only)

At the Friday, May 12, 2017, American Belgian Malinois Club National Specialty, the dog designated Reserve Winners Dog and the bitch designated Reserve Winners Bitch will be awarded a three-point major, provided that the number of dogs competing in the regular classes of the Reserve Winners' sex totals at least twice the number required for a five-point major in the region in which the event is held.

Non-Regular Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries (NATIONAL SPECIALTY ONLY)

As a judge's decision in the Non-Regular Multiple Dog Entry Classes are based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes

- Stud Dog Class: For Stud Dogs and at least two, and not more than, four of their Get. Stud Dogs MUST be entered in the Stud Dog Class and shown in the ring with their Get. Owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of the Get. Award will be based on the merits of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under Dog Show Rules, AKC policy or the standard of the breed. Get must be individually entered in one of the breed classes in this show for which it is eligible. The Stud Dog may be neutered.
- Brood Bitch Class: Same as Stud Dog, except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get. The Brood Bitch may be spayed.
- ▶ Brace Class: Each Brace shall be compromised of two dogs of either sex with at least one common owner and presented by a maximum of two handlers. The dogs compromising a Brace MUST be named at the time of entry. Dogs entered in Brace Class do not have to be entered in any other class, but full particulars must be given for each dog on individual regular entry forms. If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising each Brace must be so designated "Brace 1", "Brace 2", etc.
- Generations: For three dogs, regardless of sex, of three successive generations (grandparent, parent, offspring). Entry is made for each dog (three separate entry forms) and there can be no substitution of dogs. One additional entry fee is required for the unit of three dogs. At least one of the three dogs in the unit must be entered in a regular conformation class. Individual dogs may be entered in only ONE Generations Class unit. Each dog must have a separate handler.

PLEASE NOTE:

Rally Pairs: Rally Pairs class consists of competition by one handler working two dogs at one time through a rally course at a level selected and offered by the event-giving club. Scores will be based on a possible 200 points, with ties being broken by time.

Teams (Obedience & Rally): The team class will be for teams of any four (4) dogs. Five dogs may be entered, one to be considered an alternate for which no entry fee will be required. However, the same four dogs will perform all exercises. No dog may be entered on more than one team (obedience and rally are separate events; dogs may be entered in both Obedience Team and Rally Team.)

A separate entry form must be completed for each dog entered. Each entry form MUST designate the other entries that make up the team. There is only ONE entry fee per "unit."

Bitches in Season: If a bitch entered in the obedience or rally classes comes in season after the Trial's closing date, the entry will be fully refunded.

Transfers (formerly called move-ups): After a dog earns a title, it may be transferred to another class in a future trial, even though the closing date for the trial has passed. A transfer (i.e., from an obedience class to an obedience class or a rally class to a rally class) may be requested if, according to the owner's records the handler and dog are eligible and the dog has completed the requirements for the title after the closing date of the trial in which the advanced entry is to be made. The request for a transfer must be in writing and presented to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. Transfers may be approved provided the class and judge are available, and the class has not reached its limit. Movement between an "A" and "B" class at the same level is not considered a transfer – refer to Chapter 1, Section 16b.

4-6 MONTH BEGINNER PUPPY WEDNESDAY (Regional) & FRIDAY (National Specialty)

(NOT Divided by Sex) (Entry Fee, Per Day, is \$22.00)

For dogs that are four months of age and over, but under six months on the day of the event.

- AKC registration # or an AKC litter # is required.
- A foreign born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.
- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies).
- Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class, but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP (National Specialty)

(Entry Fee is \$22.00 if First Entry of the Dog - FREE as an additional entry)

NOVICE CLASS: This class shall be for boys and girls, who at the time entries close, have not won three first places, with competition present, in a Novice class at a licensed or member show.

Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition present after the closing of entries for a show <u>are required</u> to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by <u>notifying</u> the Superintendent or Show Secretary at least one-half hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show.

OPEN CLASS: This class shall be for boys and girls who have won three first place awards in a Novice class in a licensed or member show, with competition present. The winner of a Novice Class shall automatically become eligible, upon notice to the Open Class ring steward, to enter and compete in the Open Class at the same show provided the win is the 3rd first place award with competition and further providing there are one or more junior handlers competing in the Open Class.

MASTER CLASS: This class shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 first place wins in an Open class with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be November 1 – October 31 of the following year. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed, all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

The Novice and Open Classes will be divided into **Junior**, **Intermediate and Senior** divisions. The **Junior** class is for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show.

The **Intermediate** class shall be for the boys and girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years on the day of the show.

The **Senior** class shall be for boys and girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show.

The **Master** class shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 first place wins in an Open class with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be November 1 – October 31 of the following year. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed, all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

BEST JUNIOR HANDLER: The junior handler placed first in each of the regular Junior Showmanship Classes, if undefeated in any other Junior Showmanship Class at this show, shall automatically be eligible to compete for this prize.
