### **GENERAL INFORMATION AND TEST RULES**

Assumption of risk: ABTC, its officers and representatives, the Event Secretary, committee, site owner and livestock owner assume no responsibility for loss, damage or injuries sustained by spectators, exhibitors, exhibitors' property, and their dogs and assume no responsibility for injury to children.

- 1. <u>Completion of entries.</u> Make check or money order payable to: DTCCU. Mail <u>check</u>, <u>entry form</u> (on enclosed AKC Form or facsimile) and <u>certification</u> (where applicable) to: Cathy Greenfield, 3 River Valley Ranch, White Heath, IL 61884. Entries will not be accepted without signature and entry fee(s).
- 2. <u>Bitches in season</u>. Bitches in season MAY participate provided that the test secretary and judges are notified of same prior to the drawing of tracks. The last track(s) laid shall be for the bitch(es) in season. If there is more than one bitch in season, a second draw for these bitches will be held. Bitches in season will be allowed to participate in a test only after all the other dogs and bitches not in season have been tested.
- 3. <u>Drawing for entry acceptance</u>. A drawing will be held at the home of the test secretary on March 30 at 6:30 pm to determine which entrants will participate in the Test and the position of excess entrants on the Alternate List. All entrants will be advised via email of the results of the draw.
- 4. <u>Drawing for track position</u>. Track order will be drawn by lot at 8:00 A.M. for TD exhibitors and for TDX tracks at 9:30 A.M. on the day of the Test at the Test Site Headquarters. Entrants and alternates must be present at this drawing to guarantee their participation in the Test. The first tracks will be run immediately follow the draw.
- 5. <u>Refunds</u>. Entry fees will be refunded to alternates who decline to be placed on the Alternate List. Also, entry fees of alternates who do not participate in the Test will be refunded. Entry fees will <u>not</u> be refunded to a scheduled entrant who is absent on the Test Day <u>unless</u> an alternate is present and runs in the place of the absent dog.
- 6. <u>Hours and rules</u>. The test hours are from 6:00 A.M. until 3:30 P.M. Exhibitors and guests should observe Sullivan Regional Airport rules in effect at the time of the Test. Permission to use properties in and around Sullivan, Missouri is for this Tracking Test only. Practicing at the site is prohibited. All dogs must be on lead at all times. Animals are NOT allowed in the building at any time. We ask that you use the dedicated exercise area and always clean up after your dog.
- 7. Trophies. Trophies will be awarded to each qualifying dog at the completion of the test.

#### INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. (Variety) If you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, particolor), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in. Over 13 in. But not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, Miniature, standard).
- 2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
- 4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to AKC. (For complete rule refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
