Theresa Kulb September 28, 1959 - June 23, 2025

We are grateful to be able to pay homage to a member of the American Belgian Malinois Club, posthumously, Theresa Kulb. Theresa served the ABMC as Agility Chair and Agility Hall of Fame Chair for many years. She devoted a great deal of time to vetting and personally congratulating each Agility Hall of Fame applicant. Presenting the Hall of Fame plaques to all owners and breeders whose Malinois achieved this honor in all venues gave Theresa much joy.

Theresa was a common fixture at the ABMC National Specialty, where she could often be found volunteering wherever she was needed and greeting fellow Malinois owners with a delightful smile. Theresa was welcoming to all new ABMC members and new participants in dog sports. She was always willing to lend a helping hand, give a welcoming smile or even give individuals a few pointers on how to better train their dog. While Theresa's sports of choice were Agility and Tracking, she could often be found in the conformation ring, participating in FastCat trials or Trick Dog evaluations, and doing her part, both volunteering and participating in the Obedience and Rally rings.

Theresa's passion for the Belgian Malinois is exemplified in the titles, representing multiple venues that she competed in. "Pete" CT TriSorts Fly Me High Chewie TDX2, TDA, RN, TDU, BCAT, CGC, TKA, OA, OAJ was the fourth Malinois to obtain the Champion Tracker title. Theresa most successful dog was K, GCH CH AGCH2 MACH9 PACH2 TriSorts Tko Total Knock Out CD RA MXG3 PDG MJG3 PJG MXP5 MXPS MJP6 MJPS PAX2 MFC TQX MFPB TQXP T2B10 CGCA CGCU TKA.

Theresa was always completely put together. She was cheerful and positive. Rarely did she share her own health issues or the challenges and obstacles in her own life. She never hesitated to help with rescue, put on trials and specialties, assist others with their dogs or to volunteer to do home visits for prospective puppy buyers when a fellow breeder would ask.

Theresa Kulb was a living example of the AKC Code of Sportsmanship & Civility. Until her passing, June 23, 2025, she volunteered with rescue, always helping with whatever was needed at the time. Theresa's main concern was the welfare of the dog in question and she always went the extra mile for Belgian Malinois.

She exemplified the "Sportspeople conduct themselves in a manner that reflects positively on the sport, the American Kennel Club, and themselves" bullet point of the AKC Code of Sportsmanship & Civility in many ways. Most noteworthy is her attention to details and other dog sports participants. A fellow ABMC member, Carol Shields, recently published this memory of Theresa which exemplified this bullet perfectly; "During the 2016 National Specialty in Virginia I was taking part in the bidding for the silent auction. One of the pieces offered was a print of a Malinois with sheep. It was just beautiful, so I began to place my bids. As the final hour approached, I lost the print to another bidder. Fast forward to a few years later, I received a package in the mail. Upon opening it , there was the print, beautifully framed with a note inside "this is for you" - I cried as I sat admiring the gift. The gift was from Theresa Klub. This piece sits in my dog room in my home in Maine and I will always treasure it as well as my love for Theresa."

"Sportspeople recognize that they are role models in the sport, and strive to lead by example through humility, kindness, and ethical conduct", definitely describes Theresa Kulb's life in dog sports as well as her daily life in general. She chose a career in public service when she became a Nurse. After serving in the U.S. Army Nurse Corps, Theresa went on to earn both a BSN and MSN degrees. She was also a nurse consultant for Kimberly Clark Corp for many years. She met her husband, Dr. Thomas Kulb, in the operating room at the VA hospital in Indianapolis. She was the Director of Surgery at St. Joseph hospital for several years, which she dearly loved.

Theresa was a second generation Belgian Malinois owner. She was living example of "Sportspeople appreciate those that have gone before them and realize they are responsible for maintaining and enhancing the sport for future generations" as she continued owning and trialing Belgian Malinois just as her mother did. Theresa never expected more than her dogs could give, she just expected them to give her their all, which they happily did. Each time Theresa and her dogs headed into or out of a ring, her dogs were always happily wagging their tails and thrilled to be with Theresa.

Theresa Kulb demonstrated the AKC Code of Sportsmanship and Civility in her participation in dog sports, volunteering with the American Belgian Malinois Club, and daily in her personal life and career. It is our great honor to nominate the late Theresa Kulb for the AKC Presidents Sportsmanship Award.

Dear Malinois family and friends,

My apologies if you've already received this, but I'm learning that for some reason some of you may have not when I first sent it out. And my apologies if this is the first news you have that we have lost her.

About five years ago she was diagnosed with myleodysplastic syndromes (MDS), a rare bone marrow disorder that prevents the formation of mature red cells. So far, it was just severe anemia, but eventually would have become leukemia. In late July, she went into the hospital with covid & pneumonia. Recovery was going well, but then she became increasingly nonresponsive, the initial thought was possibly "original" covid, or something just overwhelming her fragile system, related to her MDS and long-standing asthma. They finally ordered a CT, which revealed a massive stroke. It was all just too much, and she died on the 10th of August.

As we prepare to celebrate her life, we are creating a virtual memorial service to honor her memory. Instead of a traditional in-person gathering, we will be putting together a video that includes tributes, photos, and stories from those who loved her most.

Her beloved and very talented niece, Melinda Windsor, has graciously volunteered to take the lead, for which I am incredibly grateful. As most of you know, I was the (very) low-tech half of our marriage!
